Mimisha Boots is a 4th grader at Jackson Elementary. She likes to read and play with Bratz dolls.

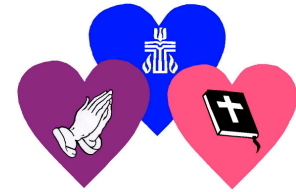
Seth Jackson is a 1st grader at Jackson Elementary. His favorite thing to do is play Star Wars video games.

Lincoln Currie is a kindergartner at Bowman Woods Elementary. He likes playing and watching baseball.

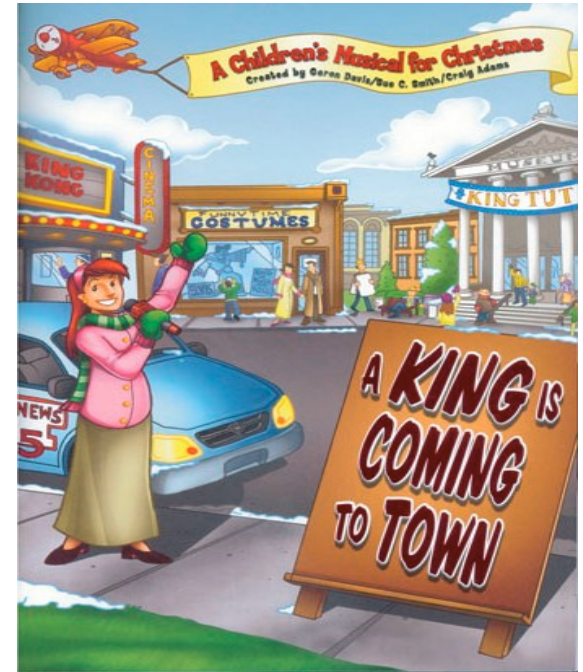
Joshua Jackson is in preschool. He likes to pretend to read and play with toys.

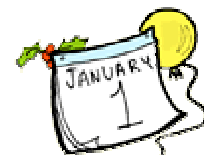
